SMALL GROUP GUIDE

GATHERING PRAYER

Invite the participants to pray and welcome the Holy Spirit into this space. Take a few moments in silence, allowing them to become aware of His presence.

- What is the greatest challenge that you have to being still to let the Lord fight for you and with you? What resolution will you make today to allow him space to fight your battles?

Close in prayer, asking for any special intentions.

SUPPLEMENTAL QUESTIONS

- Who has been a witness of spiritual motherhood to you? This could be your own mother, a friend, or even a Saint or public figure.
- Specify some areas of your heart that you feel excitement about the idea of exercising your spiritual motherhood. These could be in your home, in discipling others, in service, in friendship, in how you deal with extended family etc.
